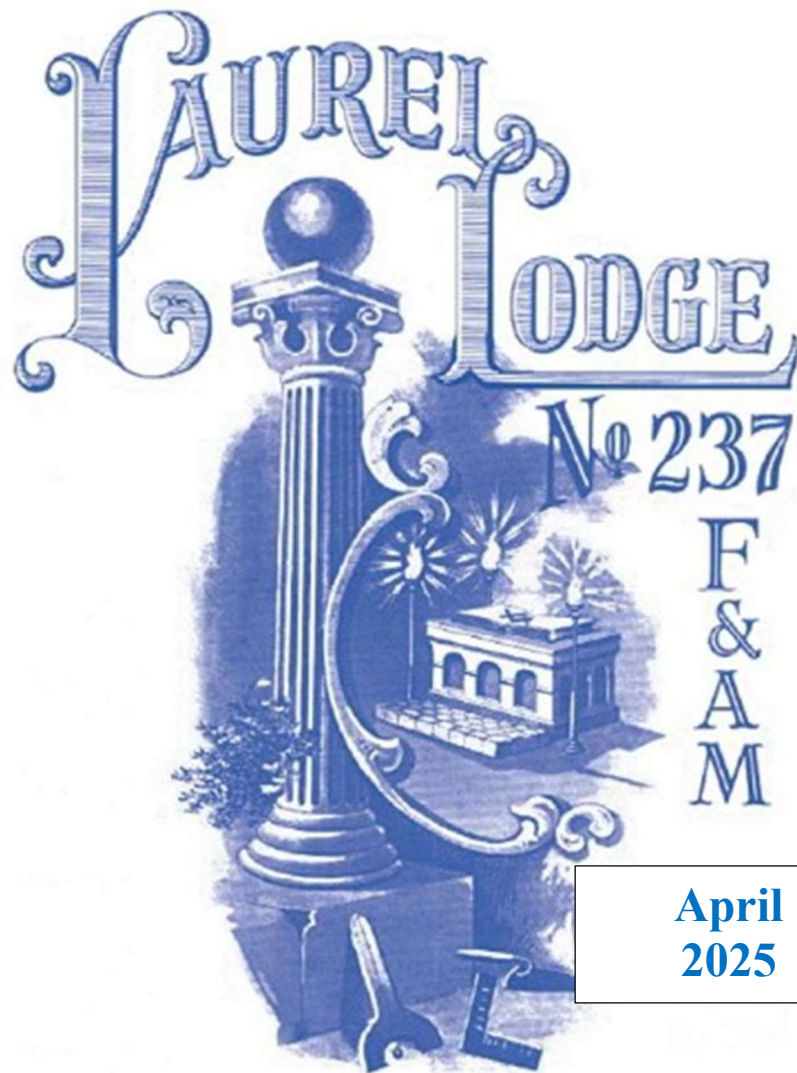

### **The View from the West R.W.Scott P Vicari ATTGM**

The reception for the 18th and 21st districts will be on Monday, April 14th. I am excited to have my second reception as a Grand Lodge officer, especially because I get to share this night with so many good friends and brothers of the 18th district, including my brother-in-law, Right Worshipful Brother Casey Huston. I'm a little apprehensive about the date, which is one of the worst dates in history. No less than three major tragedies occurred on this date:

- President Lincoln was shot on April 14th, 1865, in the Ford theater
- The Titanic struck an iceberg on April 14th, 1912, and eventually sank in the wee hours of April 15th
- The Black Sunday dust storm, one of the worst storms of the "Dust Bowl" swept across the Oklahoma and Texas panhandles on April 14th, 1935.

To add to that, April 14th, 1861, was the day that Fort Sumter was evacuated, ending the first battle of the civil war (the battle started on April 12th) which would go on to claim about 620,000 American lives. Interestingly, both commanders involved in the battle, the Union Commander Major Robert Anderson and Confederate General P.G.T Beauregard, were both Freemasons. You will be glad to know that no freemasons were involved in the assassination of President Lincoln, but that didn't stop some conspiracy theorists at the time from suggesting that John Wilkes Booth was a Freemason, and that he committed the deadly deed in the pursuit of some wicked plan of the fraternity. Thankfully, these accusations, coming some 39 years after the Morgan Affair, never gained any traction and were quickly disproved.

Out of the 2,240 passengers and crew of the Titanic, 29 were Freemasons. Nine were in First Class, six in Second Class, three in Third Class and the remaining thirteen part of the crew. The only Freemasons to survive the sinking were Bro. Doctor Will Frauenthal, Bro. Elmer Taylor, Bro. John Hardy, Bro. Arago Harrison, Bro. Herbert Pitman and Bro. James Widgery. The remaining 23 brothers perished in the icy waters of the North Atlantic. Anyone reading this message would no doubt not be surprised to learn that many of the brothers on the Titanic were reported to have acted bravely and selflessly, willingly sacrificing their lives for the sake of others. The Black Sunday dust storm displaced an estimated 300,000 tons of topsoil and forced the relocation of hundreds of thousands of people. I was not able to find records on the number of Freemasons affected by the storm, but I would guess it was significant. Here's hoping our reception doesn't hit any icebergs this April 14th!

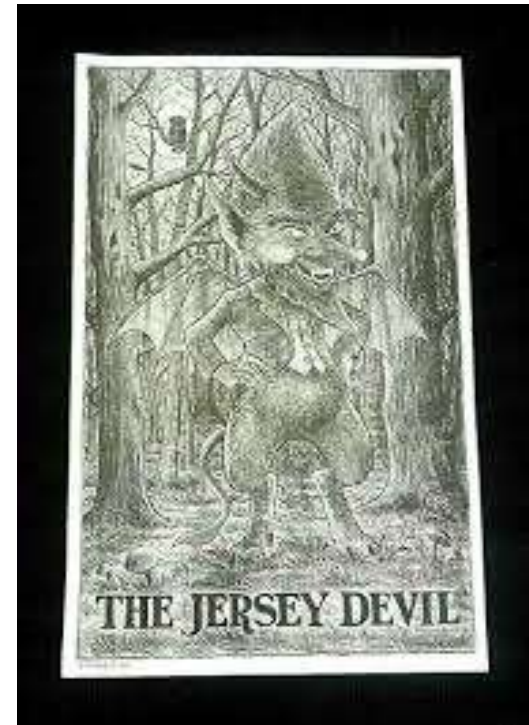
